

Old Saybrook Rotary Scholarship Application

This year Old Saybrook Rotary will award scholarships to students in each of the following towns: Old Saybrook, Old Lyme, Westbrook. Awards will be paid directly to the college or trade school in which the student enrolls upon submission of a transcript showing achievement of at least a 2.30 GPA after the first semester.

Scholarships are based on the student's ability to meet the following criteria:

- Must be a high school senior eligible to graduate
- Academic ability
- Leadership abilities in the school and the community
- Participation in extracurricular activities
- Resourcefulness by working summers, weekends or during vacations to help meet anticipated expenses.
- Need for financial assistance
- Intent to pursue their education in an institution of high learning, including trade schools.
- Although not required, participation in Rotary Activities such as Interact Club, RYLA, World Affairs Conference, Student of the month would be considered a plus.

Application Procedure: All application materials should be scanned in as ONE document and emailed to oldsaybrookrotaryscholarship@gmail.com by April 6, 2023. Only <u>completed</u> applications submitted <u>on time</u> will be considered.

ALL MATERIALS WILL BE REVIEWED USING A BLIND PROCESS UP UNTIL INTERVIEWS. PLEASE DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON ANY OF THE DOCUMENTS EXCEPT THE APPLICATION PAGE.

- Complete and submit this application form
- Resume/ Highlighting (1) co-curricular activities; (2) leadership positions; (3) service activities;
 (4) work experiences, including number of days, and (5) academic honors, over the past four years. This can be arranged in the form of a chart if you choose
- _ Submit a 200-300 word max essay that lists your interests, ambitions, concerns and specific plans for the future. **Do not put your name on the essay.**
- _ Submit <u>only</u> 2 letters of recommendation **Be sure to redact your name**.
- Submit the Scholarship Financial Information with copies of schools' anticipated expenses
- _ Submit a Copy of the SAR (Student Aid report) from the FAFSA.
- _ Copy of Quarter 2 report card

Once all the applications have been reviewed. Some applicants will be invited for interviews by the OS Rotary Scholarship committee in late April/early May to determine the scholarship winners for each school.

The winners will be announced at their school's Senior awards night.
